Senate Bill 1343

New California Law Requires Sexual Harassment Prevention Training for Supervisors and Non-Supervisors

Since 2005, California employers with at least 50 employees have been required to train and educate supervisory personnel in the prevention of sexual harassment. New Senate Bill 1343 expands that requirement to employers with as few as five employees, and by requiring training for non-supervisors in the mandate. Employer must meet the new requirement by no later than January 1, 2020.
